- Shannon was signed to Capitol Records where she released the critically acclaimed “Jukebox Sparrows,” which spawned the AAA hit “Now That I Know” featured in the movie “Sweet Home Alabama.”
- Her latest album, “Windswept Moon,” was produced by Jim Dickinson and includes a duet with Ray LaMontagne titled “Hangs Sweetly On The Vine.”
- In her career, Shannon has sold over 60,000 albums.
- Her biggest touring markets include New Orleans, Austin, New York City, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Baltimore, San Francisco, Oxford, MS and Woodstock, NY.
- Some of her radio “friends” include WFUV (New York City), KGSR (Austin), WXPB (Philadelphia), KMTT (Seattle), WWOZ (New Orleans), WDST (Woodstock, NY), XM Radio (“The Loft”).
- Shannon has toured with Willie Nelson, John Mellencamp, Stevie Nicks, Son Volt, Ryan Adams, Robert Randolph and The Family Band, The Derek Trucks Band, Rufus Wainwright, Rhett Miller, Five For Fighting and many more.
- She was personally invited by legendary songwriter and musician Bobby Charles (of “See You Later Alligator” fame) to sit in during his most recent performance at the New Orleans Jazz and Heritage Festival.
- In 2007, she was nominated for two “Big Easy Awards” in New Orleans.
